



PEISHA Membership Information

[The Prince Edward Island Speech and Hearing Association](#) (PEISHA) exists to promote professional development through discussions and workshops. The association also disseminates information about the professions, speech-language and hearing disorders to the public, government and other agencies.

PEISHA has joint membership with CASLPA ([Canadian Association of Speech Language Pathology and Audiology](#)). Members in shared membership categories will become members of PEISHA upon joining CASLPA.

These shared membership categories are:

- Full member - Masters degree in SLP or Aud or equivalent.
PEISHA fee \$100.00* CASLPA fee \$243.55
- Full member certified - Certified members must successfully complete the certification exam, must have acquired 350 supervised clinical hours, must hold a master's degree in SLP or aud or equivalent and must meet ongoing continuing education equivalent requirements.
PEISHA Fee \$100.00* CASLPA fee \$243.55
- Student member - must be enrolled in a Canadian or American graduate university program in human communication disorders.
Fee: none
- Reduced hours member- meet above criteria for full or full certified membership but working less than 800 hours annually.
PEISHA Fee \$67.50* CASLPA Fee \$162.36.

PEISHA has 4 other membership categories. Individuals wishing to join PEISHA in these categories should contact the membership chair.

- Supportive Personnel Member - is a graduate of an educational program for supportive personnel in Speech-Language Pathology or Audiology. Or is a current member of CASLPA in the supportive personnel category.
PEISHA fee \$50.00*
- Associate member - persons from related disciplines may be considered for Associate Membership.
Fee \$50.00**
- Honourary member - May be offered to any individual who has provided outstanding service to the field of communication disorders.
Fee: none
- Retired member - meets above criteria for full membership but is not practicing and has no intention of re-entering the workforce in the professional designations of SLP or Aud.
PEISHA retired member Fee \$10.00 **
